Practitioners and those that have earned a Certificate of Accomplishment for the study of the Del Giacco Neuro Arts Therapy Program; the "CDAT" Practitioners have been Credentialed and are certified in Del Giacco Neuro Arts Therapy Program. Practitioners are required to have a verifiable Bachelor's Degree or higher with studies in related fields and or the equivalent there of 1 year practice. In addition, they must complete our course of study and write a ten page paper. The Practitioner has also demonstrated good critical thinking skills, good judgment, empathy, the ability to interact professionally in a respectful manner, have had their credentials and final paper reviewed and accepted by

the Professional Peer Review Committee who make up The American Neuro Art Therapy Institute. Practitioners who hold a “CDATA” or Advanced Certificate are required to have completed all of the aspects for the “CDAT” Certificate and then have been invited by Dr. Del Giacco to study for the Advanced course, have attended a 6 week training class on line “live” with other Practitioners, have read 6 case studies and other assigned reading, have completed a 2 day clinical with Dr. Del Giacco and completed a combination of high level critical thinking skills and demonstrated the practice of all the subject matter. The Practitioner must have demonstrated outstanding character, the ability to function under high levels of stress and to be of responsible character. The Practitioner must also have demonstrated a clinical understanding of the practice of Del Giacco Neuro Art Therapy in an advanced capacity.
