You are applying for the credential of “CDAT” or Certified in Del Giacco Art Therapy. This credential allows you the right to use the initials CDAT after your name to identify your comprehensive training in a specialized art therapy program, and that you are a Registered, Credentialed Profession in the specialty of using this arts based method for Cognitive Rehabilitation.

Please know that before certification can be awarded you must complete 10 training modules, complete a final exam and go through a background. If all of these requirements are met successfully you will be awarded a photo ID and a Certificate of completion. Certification allows you the right and privilege to use the mark of CDAT or Del Giacco Art therapy after your name. Using the CDAT Mark will identify that you have met the standards required and have completed the Del Giacco art based cognitive rehabilitation program.
